#### SPECIAL EXHIBIT INCLUDES STACEY TORRES



Your participation is encouraged in *PSALMS REVISITED*, an art exhibition that interprets biblical psalms through the lens of systemic racism.

Sponsored by St. Christopher's Episcopal Church, 1402 W. Main Street in Carmel, the exhibition features work by Indiana Black, Indigenous, and/or Persons of Color in combination with work by persons affiliated with the congregation.

Artwork will be installed along a directional path that traverses the congregation's Parish Hall and culminates in a station designated for reflection. Masks are required and social distancing will be observed.

PSALMS REVISITED will be available for viewing from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, October 17 and 18, and from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, October 24 and 25. A Closing Celebration, scheduled for 11 a.m. on Sunday, October 25, will offer opportunities for conversation among participating artists, community guests, and congregation members.

#### **ELECTION SEASON REMINDER**

Election Season is officially upon us. I encourage all of us consider carefully how we will exercise our democratic stewardship by voting. I'm providing this summary for guidance.—Deacon Barry

<u>Voter Registration deadline</u> (including change of address) is <u>Monday, October 5</u> (by close of office if in-person, by midnight if online, or with a postmark if by mail).

<u>Absentee voting</u> (with an identified reason, including age) carries a deadline for REQUESTS for ballots of <u>Thursday</u>, <u>October 22</u>. DEADLINE to return absentee ballot of <u>Monday</u>, <u>Nov. 3</u>, at Noon (whether in person or by mail).

<u>Early Voting</u> (in person) begins Tuesday, October 6, and runs through Monday, November 3, at Noon.
