We may have a choir of 4 masked choir members that are distanced 6 ft apart. Once everyone is vaccinated, the congregation can sing while masked.

If we meet OUTSIDE, we do not need to wear masks unless we are singing.

Standard cleaning practices are accepted now so the kitchen is opened. We still can not have coffee hour inside.
